OUR PARISH YEAR OF RENEWAL continues with new Sacramental programmes, including pioneering the **new YouCat Confirmation Course** (as another national 'first' for our Parish!); our **new all-age Youth Movement**; and the appointment of our **new Pastoral Assistant** (see his personal profile on the flip side of next Sunday's Bulletin).

ARE YOU THINKING ABOUT BECOMING A CATHOLIC? - or exploring what the Catholic Church believes and teaches - rather than what people think Catholics believe! Are you (or someone you know) thinking about returning to the Catholic Church? Or did you miss out on Confirmation and want to prepare for it now in adulthood? Talk, this week, to Fr Peter, Deacon John-Simon, Maureen Sampson, or one of the many adults who've been Baptized or Received into the Catholic Church here in recent years. The RCIA programme runs **(7.45 - 9.15pm) on Thursdays starting on 11th September.**

THE CONFIRMATION PROGRAMME begins on **Sunday 14th September at 7pm** with an introductory information evening for all the Parents and the young Confirmandi (who have registered and received a welcome letter and the programme timetable); and then continues every Friday from 5.30 to 7pm. You are also members of Take A Stand (below).

TAKE A STAND Youth Movement (for Confirmandi and early teens to 35 year olds) meets after the 5.30pm Mass on **2nd & 4th Sundays of every month**, starting on 28th September.

THE FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME information evening (for all Parents who have registered and received a timetable) is at 7.30pm on Thursday 2nd October.

FOOD BANK COLLECTION NEXT SUNDAY, and on the 1st Sunday of every month.
