FATHER UCHE NJOKU has been appointed by the Archbishop as the new Parish Priest of New Malden, with effect from mid-day on Monday 5th September. Fr Peter gave him a conducted tour of the parish last week, and we look forward to his arrival at St Joseph's at the start of the new academic year. Read Fr Uche brief introduction of himself overleaf at the top of page two.

FATHER PETER officially hands over on 5th September, but his Farewell Lunch is next Sunday (24th July) and he moves from the Parish at the end of this month.

However, the start of the new Oratory at Bournemouth is delayed from Our Lady's Birthday (8th September) to the Immaculate Conception (8th December).

FATHER DAVID HUTTON, one of the three priests for the new Oratory, and Fr Peter's close personal friend, has been diagnosed with an aggressive cancer - so Fr Peter goes to be his carer, and cover Masses etc at his Parish of Hayes (near Bromley) during his surgery, radio/chemo-therapy etc, and convalescence.

Please pray for Fr David, and for the new Oratory, to St Philip Neri (16th century founder of the Oratory), and to Blessed John Henry Newman, who brought the Oratory to England, so that Fr Dominic Jacob, Cong. Orat., Fr David and Fr Peter can go to start the new Oratory at Bournemouth later in the year.

FR PHILIP ANDREWS and **FR JOSEPH LUZINDANA** will be resident here in the Presbytery, and caring for New Malden Parish, between Fr Peter's departure at the end of July, and Fr Uche's arrival on Monday 5th September. Please pray for them, especially as Fr Philip begins his Priestly ministry with us.

OUR NEW PARISH PRIEST'S BRIEF INTRODUCTION

My name is **Fr Uche Njoku**. Born in Nigeria on 13th July 1967, the first of 8 children. I have 4 brothers and 3 sisters. I joined the Holy Ghost Fathers at the age of 16 and was ordained a priest on 23rd July 1994. I worked in Guinea Conakry as a missionary for 9 years before coming to England in 2005. Between 2005 and 2006 I studied for a Masters degree in Justice and Peace at Missionary Institute London (Middlesex University London). From January 2007 to June 2007, I was assistant priest at St Peter the Apostle Church, Leamington Spa. From June 2007 to January 2012: Parish Priest at St Philip Neri Church, Smethwick, and Priest Chaplain at St Paul's School for Girls, Edgbaston all in the Archdiocese of Birmingham. From April 2012 to November 2015, Parish Priest at Our Lady of Grace Church, Charlton. In September 2015 I decided to leave the Holy Ghost Fathers and I applied to the Archdiocese of Southwark for Incardination. In March 2016 I was appointed Parochial Administrator of St John Fisher Church Merton (on Canon Acton's retirement), and on 13th June 2016, I was Incardinated into the Archdiocese of Southwark. I was very happy and excited when I was asked to move to St Joseph's, New Malden, and I am looking forward with hope and joy to serving the brethren here.

FATHER UCHE'S first Sunday at St Joseph's will be 11th September, and his Induction as Parish Priest announced shortly thereafter. Please pray for him as he prepares to move to New Malden on Monday 5th September.

MESSAGE FROM FATHER PHILIP ANDREWS:

Dear friends, thank you all, so very much, for the many kind messages and gifts which I've received. You, the wonderful parishioners of St Joseph's, have been so generous in supporting me over these past six years with your love and prayers. I am, therefore, excited that in these coming weeks, until I take up my first appointment, I shall have the opportunity to serve you as a priest in this, my wonderful HOME parish; serving people I consider to be not only friends, but dear family.
