THIS SUNDAY is Education Sunday: The 2nd Collection is for the Catholic Education Service, which acts on behalf of the Catholic Bishops' Conference to support Catholic Education. There are over 2000 Catholic schools, academies & colleges in England educating over 800,000 pupils. The CES is the chief negotiating & advisory body on all aspects of Catholic education, also providing financial support for school transport in rural areas.
