**FATHER PETER writes:** Thank you to everyone for the past 18 years as your Parish Priest, also for the wonderful Farewell Lunch at the end of July, and your generous offerings, both to me personally, and for the new Oratory-in-Formation at Bournemouth. I am sorry that there was not opportunity to say good-bye to everyone, but keep you all regularly in my prayers. Keep in touch!

The **new Oratory** has been postponed until the New Year, as one of the three Founding Fathers (Fr David Hutton, known to many at St Joseph's) is recovering from a serious cancer operation, and whose 6 week radiotherapy begins on 19th September. The Archbishop has agreed that I be Fr David's Primary Carer, and cover Masses etc in his Parish of Our Lady of the Rosary at Hayes (near Bromley) through this, and his 2-3 months' convalescence. Our Colleague, Fr Dominic Jacob, Cong. Orat., meanwhile continues at the Oxford Oratory (where he was a Co-Founder 26 years ago) until we can all three move to the Sacred Heart, Bournemouth. Please continue praying for Fr David, and for the new Oratory.
